Matthew 4 - (NKJV)

Satan Tempts Jesus

4 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. 2 And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. 3 Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

4 But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

5 Then the devil took Him up into the holy city, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, **6** and said to Him, "If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down. For <u>it is written</u>: 'He shall give His angels charge over you,' and,

'In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone." 7 Jesus said to him, "It is written again, 'You shall not tempt the Lord your God."

8 Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory.
9 And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me."

- 10 Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! *For it is written*, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve."
- 11 Then the devil left Him, and behold, angels came and ministered to Him.

Essential Food

Matthew 4:4

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

Job 23:12 (NKJV)

I have not departed from the commandment of His lips;

I have <u>treasured the words of His mouth</u> More than my necessary food.

Matthew 24:35

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

Mark 13:31

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

Luke 21:33

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

We believe in the verbal, plenary (unqualified; absolute), infallible, inerrant, inspiration of the Bible.

Verbal - God actually spoke these very words.

Plenary - means full - we believe <u>all</u> the Bible was spoken by God and is inspired.

Infallible - It is a good rule for our lives. It is the only rule we have for our lives.

Inerrant - without error in the original manuscripts.

Inspiration - God breathed it and inspired it.

2 Timothy 3:16 (NKJV)

All Scripture *is* given *by inspiration of God*, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness,

The word of God is *Living*

Hebrews 4:12 (NIV)

12 For the word of God is <u>alive</u> and <u>active</u>. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Matthew 22:29 (NIV)

Jesus replied, "You are <u>in error</u> because you <u>do not know the Scriptures</u> or the power of God.

Hosea 4:6 (NIV)

my people are <u>destroyed from lack of</u> <u>knowledge</u>.

"Because you have rejected knowledge,
I also reject you as my priests;
because you have ignored the law of your
God,

Galatians 2:11

When they arrived, they went into the synagogue of the Jews. 11 These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and searched the Scriptures daily to find out whether these things were so. 12 Therefore many of them believed, and also not a few of the Greeks, prominent women as well as men.
