Rhema

Speak of My love – Father's love, of My jealousy and passion for all of My creatures. Speak of the free will of men. Choice. "Choose you this day whom you will serve." All of My people are called to serve Me full time. All you are and do is for My glory and for the honouring of My Name. Do not be conformed to the mindset of the world. Open your minds to Me. Meditate on My Word. Don't settle for less than I have for you.

Rhema

The world strives for possessions and for enough to supply their needs. It is in giving that you receive. You are each blessed through My love, and so that you can be a blessing for others. All My gifts are like this. I bless you as you receive and others as you give. In this way one gift touches many hearts and grows as it is given away.

Be generous in giving away what I have given to you.

God is good

My son I AM indeed good and My intention and desire for you and My people is also good. There is no darkness in Me. I AM all good, all light, all wholeness, all in all.

This is the message we have heard from Him and announce to you, that God is Light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. 1 John 1:5 NASB No one is good except God alone. Mark 10:18b NASB Christ is all, and in all Col 3:11b NASB We are blessed

Speak blessings to My people. Encourage them that I AM good and that I love to bless them.

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ Eph 1:3 NASB

Note He has already blessed us - past tense.

Blessings move from the spiritual realm to the physical by the power of the spoken word. Death and life are in the power of the tongue. Declare the blessings out loud and believe that the word of God is true. You will then receive. Previous teaching from Deut 28.

Note from my previous teaching Balaam blessed Israel because he thought he would receive a blessing (Num 24:9). We have already received every spiritual blessing because of Jesus – not as a reward for what we do.

Poverty mindset vs God's kingdom Confront poverty mindsets. Seek first My kingdom.

Do not worry then, saying, 'What will we eat?' or 'What will we drink?' or 'What will we wear for clothing?' For the Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; for your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. Mt 6:31-33 NASB Poverty mindset vs God's kingdom

Confront poverty mindsets. Seek first My kingdom.

And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Phil 4:19 NASB

This promise to the Philippians was given after they had given gifts to Paul.

Gifts

Speak of My gifts, especially those that are given to facilitate the help of others, and those that are for the extension of My kingdom. Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord. There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all persons. But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. For to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, and to another the word of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit, and to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, and to another the effecting of miracles, and to another prophecy, and to another the distinguishing of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, and to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills. 1 Cor 12:4-11 Now you are Christ's body, and individually members of it. And God has appointed in the church, first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, various kinds of tongues. All are not apostles, are they? All are not prophets, are they? All are not teachers, are they? All are not workers of miracles, are they? All do not have gifts of healings, do they? All do not speak with tongues, do they? All do not interpret, do they? 31 But earnestly desire the greater gifts. 1 Cor 12:27-31 NASB

God loves us

Speak of My love – Father's love, of My jealousy and passion for all of My creatures.

God is love 1 Jn 4:8b

The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance. 2 Peter 3:9 NASB

How often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were unwilling. Mt 23:37b NASB

Free will

Speak of the free will of men. Choice. "Choose you this day whom you will serve."

And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. Joshua 24:15 AV

Full time service

All of My people are called to serve Me full time. All you are and do is for My glory and for the honouring of My Name.

And He said to them, 'Having gone to all the world, proclaim the good news to all the creation; he who hath believed, and hath been baptized, shall be saved; and he who hath not believed, shall be condemned. Mark 16:15-16 YLT "It is no use walking anywhere to preach unless our walking is our preaching." Francis of Assisi

Go is not the command, Proclaim is the command!

Wherever we are , whatever we're doing we can proclaim the gospel. We don't even need to use words!

Full time service

All of My people are called to serve Me full time. All you are and do is for My glory and for the honouring of My Name. And having come near, Jesus spake to them, saying, `Given to me was all authority in heaven and on earth; having gone, then, disciple all the nations, (baptizing them -- to the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all, whatever I did command you,) and Io, I am with you all the days -- till the full end of the age.'Matthew 28:18-20 YLT

Go is not the command, disciple is the command!

Full time service

All of My people are called to serve Me full time. All you are and do is for My glory and for the honouring of My Name.

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth." Acts 1:8 NASB

BMW Be My Witnesses (Ronnie from CMA)

Wherever we are, whatever we do – we are called to bring the light of the kingdom of God into the darkness.

Note we are not commanded to DO witnessing, but to BE witnesses.

Mindsets

Do not be conformed to the mindset of the world. Open your minds to Me. Meditate on My Word. Don't settle for less than I have for you.

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. Romans 12:2 NASB

What do we fill our minds with?

The word of God!

Don't wait to go to heaven to receive all that God has for us. The gifts He has for us are to be used here and now on the earth to glorify Him and to reach the lost.

Blessed to be a blessing

The world strives for possessions and for enough to supply their needs. It is in giving that you receive. You are each blessed through My love, and so that you can be a blessing for others. All My gifts are like this. I bless you as you receive and others as you give. In this way one gift touches many hearts and grows as it is given away.

Be generous in giving away what I have given to you.

There is an inexhaustible supply!

We sometimes act like the gift will run out! How daft is that?

Acts 20:35b (NKJV) And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"

Blessed to be a blessing

Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven. Matthew 5:16 NASB

Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, "Which," He said, "you heard of from Me; for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now." Acts 1:4-5 NASB

Bringing light into the darkness as we go about our daily lives

Notice this is a command!

The baptism of the the Holy Spirit was essential for the disciples and it is for us too. We all receive the Holy Spirit when we are saved. But there is also the baptism of the Spirit which empowers us for service.

Jesus received this after his baptism – if He needs it then so do we.

Lk 3: 21 When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened. 22 And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

Lk 4:1 Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into[a] the wilderness

Lk 4:14 Then Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and news of Him went out through all the surrounding region. 15 And He taught in their synagogues, being glorified by all.

Calling of the church Take My blessings to the world. Be My witnesses. Bring My light into the darkness and My love to the lost. Open your eyes to the opportunities that I will bring to you and see that I AM good in all that we do together.
