Christian Motorcyclists' Association History In Brief

CMA began in the USA in 1975.

There are now 27 active countries and an additional 7 countries in the forming stages.

The Christian Motorcyclists' Association UK began in 1983, known as CMA (UK) for short.

There are over 30 Branches active in the UK

We are part of CMA International and have formed close links with Christian Motorcyclists' clubs throughout the UK and Europe to help and encourage each other in sharing the Gospel.

THE BIKER BIBLE

In June 2007 the "CMA UK", in partnership with the "UK Bible Society" and "Bibles For The Nations", produced a pocket sized Biker Bible.

It was launched in June 2007 at the Centenary Isle of Man TT, and in one day alone 393 bibles were taken.

100,000 so far have been given away.

A printing run of 20,000 costs about £40,000

Many churches and individuals have sponsored the printing of a Biker Bible at a cost of £2.00 per copy.
