# Vision

## OT.

- **Vision** Hb (**chazown**) a sight; dream; revelation; oracle.
- From Hb prime root (**chazah**) to perceive; to gaze; to see; to have a vision of; behold; look; prophesy
- '**Chazown**' opens the prophetic Books of **Isaiah & Obadiah** and some visions in **Daniel**.

## NT.

- **Vision** Gk (**horama**) something gazed at; a spectacle, especially supernatural.

# Imagination

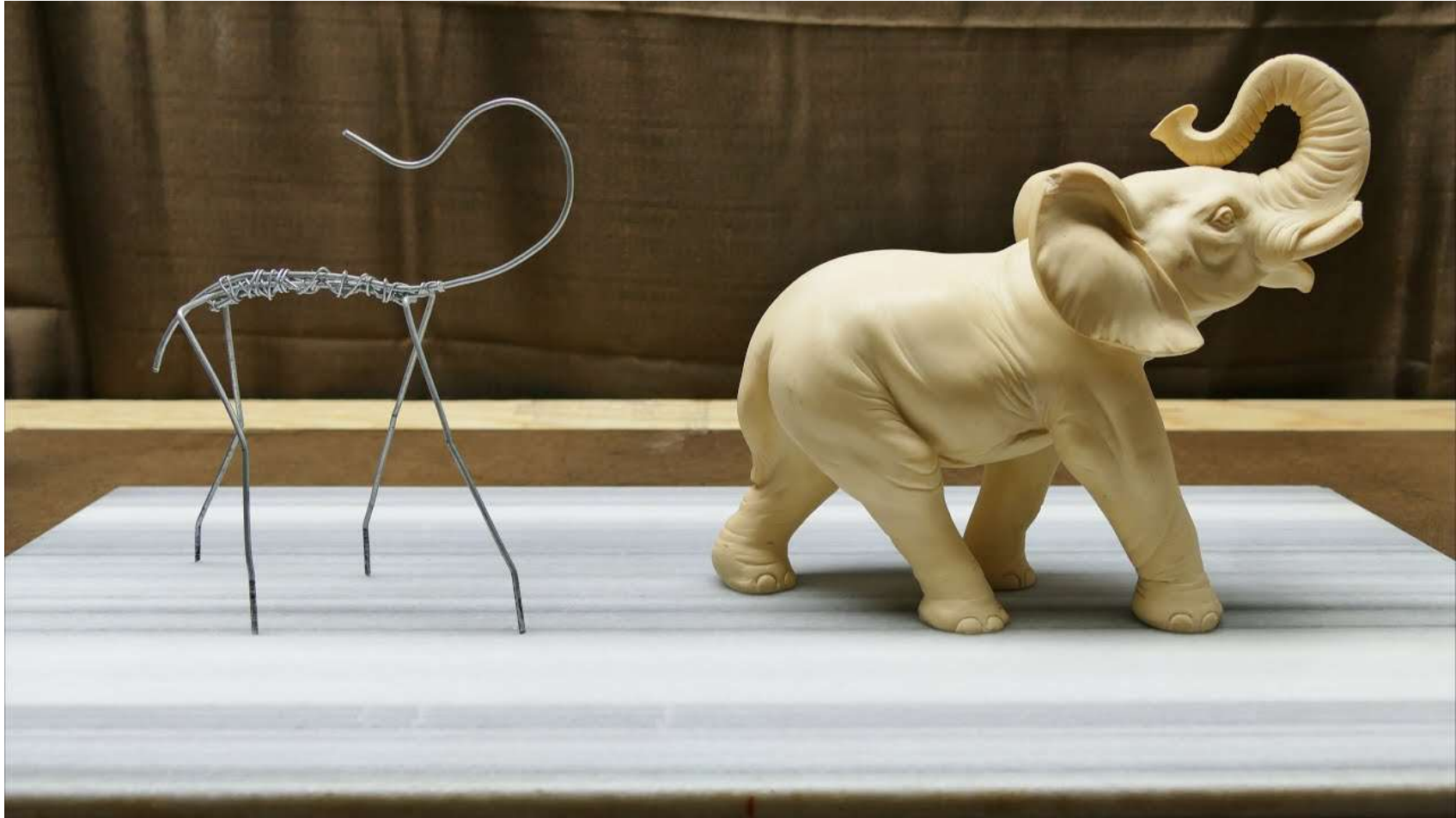
## OT.

- "Imagination" or "Mind" is translated Hb 'yetser' i.e. "**a shaping**," hence, "**a thought**" Is applied to both a good and evil imagination.
- Comes from Hb'yatsar' which carries the sense of "**squeezing in to shape**" to "**mould in to a form**" in the manner of the potter squeezing clay.

## NT.

- "Imagination" is Gk 'dianoia' "**thoughts**" a "**thinking over**"
