“For with God nothing will be impossible.” Lk 1:37 NKJV

“Ah Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You.” Jer 32:17 NASB

“Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is anything too difficult for Me?” Jer 32:27 NASB

Christmas. Angel visits Mary. Tells her that she will have a baby as a virgin and that her cousin Elizabeth who was thought to be barren is already pregnant.

“For with God nothing will be impossible.”

What looks impossible to us in 2022?

Around 586BC - Jerusalem besieged by the Babylonians, Jeremiah in jail for prophesying truth. He buys a field at God’s instruction as a sign that although the city will fall, it will be reinstated. But then he asks God why. It seems like an impossible situation. How would you start your prayer? He starts his prayer with:

“Ah Lord God! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You.” Jer 32:17 NASB – focussing on God – NOT the problem

God starts His reply with:

“Behold, I am the Lord, the God of all flesh; is anything too difficult for Me?” Jer 32:27 NASB

As in “Do you really believe nothing is too difficult for Me?”

If we’re honest, we all have some unbelief!

So let’s look at another impossible situation:

Around 1425BC Moses is preparing the people to enter the promised land. It’s full of 7 powerful nations with armies and fortified cities. It all looks impossible.

“If you should say in your heart, ‘These nations are greater than I; how can I dispossess them?’— you shall not be afraid of them, but you shall remember well what the Lord your God did to Pharaoh and to all Egypt.” Dt 7:17 NKJV

“And the Lord your God will drive out those nations before you little by little; you will be unable to destroy them at once, lest the beasts of the field become too numerous for you. But the Lord your God will deliver them over to you, and will inflict defeat upon them until they are destroyed.” Dt 7:22,23 NKJV

Moses tells them to remember what God has already done!

To confront their unbelief with testimony and to remember God’s blessings and miracles.

But he doesn’t expect them to do it all at once!

This little by little approach builds the faith of the Israelites and their unbelief becomes less and less.

This principle is for us today.

Don’t focus on the issue that seems impossible – focus on what God has already done! If God can save you, then anything else is easy for Him!
