1. The Assembly

Eph 1:22 And God placed all things under his (Jesus) feet and appointed Him to be head over everything for the church. (Ekklesia)

The Church – The Ekklesia

An Assembly- gathering of people

The called out ones

Jesus gave authority to his church

The church can use its delegated authority to affect change in the world

2. The Body

Ephesians 1:22,23

And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him over everything for the church which is his body the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

3. The Workmanship Eph 2:10

For we are God's Workmanship created in Christ Jesus to do good works which he prepared in advance for us to do.

4. The Family

Ephesians 2:19 and 14

¹⁹Consequently you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens With God's people and members of God's household. ¹⁴For he himself is our peace who has made the two one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility.

(Jew and Gentiles)

5. The Temple

Ephesians 2:20

Built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone.

A place for him to live – Christ in us.

6. The Bride

<u>Ephesians 5:25 – 32</u>

25. Husbands love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the Word 27. and present her to himself as a radiant church with out stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless 28. In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself 29 after all, no one ever hated his own body, but he feeds and cares for it, iust as Christ does the church, for we are members of his body. 30. For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united with his wife, and the two will become one flesh. But this is a profound mystery - but I am talking about Christ and the church

7. The Army

Ephesians 6:10-13

10 Finally be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armour of God so that you can take your stand against the Devil's schemes. 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms, therefore put on the full armour of God so that you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything to stand.
