


Jesus Begins to Preach

¹² When Jesus heard that John had been put in prison, he withdrew to Galilee. ¹³ Leaving Nazareth, he went and lived in Capernaum, which was by the lake in the area of Zebulun and Naphtali— ¹⁴ to fulfill what was said through the prophet

- Jesus heads out of the wilderness
- The next day, Jesus and His first disciples head to Galilee
- The day after, Jesus and disciples go to Cana, near Nazareth.
- Jesus goes to Capernaum with Mary, his brothers and disciples
- After a few days Jesus and the disciples head down to Jerusalem for the Passover celebration
- After a time, Jesus and His disciples head into the Judean countryside
- Jesus passes through Samaria on his way to Galilee to start His ministry


'You will be called Cephas' John 1 "Come ye after me"...and they followed him' Matt 4 (Miraculous catch of fish)
