⁷And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.'⁸ Heal *the* sick, raise *the* dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give



Miracles at Ephesus

¹¹God was performing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul, ¹² so that handkerchiefs or aprons were even carried from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out. ¹³ But also some of the Jewish exorcists, who went from place to place, attempted to name over those who had the evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, "I adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preaches." ¹⁴ Seven sons of one Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, were doing this. ¹⁵ And the evil spirit answered and said to them, "I recognize Jesus, and I know about Paul, but who are you?" ¹⁶ And the man, in whom was the evil spirit, leaped on them and subdued all of them and overpowered them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.¹⁷ This became known to all, both Jews and Greeks, who lived in Ephesus; and fear fell upon them all and the name of the Lord Jesus was being magnified.

How do you present Jesus ?

Worthy

⁹ Do not acquire gold, or silver, or copper for your money belts, ¹⁰ or a ^[]]bag for *your* journey, or even two ^[k]coats, or sandals, or a staff; for the worker is worthy of his ^[]]support. ¹¹ And whatever city or village you enter, inquire who is worthy in it, and stay ^[m]at his house until you leave *that city*. ¹² As you enter the ^[n]house, give it your ^[o]greeting. ¹³ If the house is worthy, ^[p]give it your *blessing of* peace.



Not Worthy

But if it is not worthy, ^[q]take back your *blessing* of peace. ¹⁴ Whoever does not receive you, nor heed your words, as you go out of that house or that city, shake the dust off your feet. ¹⁵ Truly I say to you, it will be more tolerable for *the* land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city.



Galatians 6:2

The Fear of the Lord is beginning of Wisdom

do not worry about how or what you are to say; for it will be given you in that hour what you are to say. ²⁰ For it is not you who speak, but *it is* the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you.

⁶ "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves; so be shrewd as serpents and innocent as doves. ¹⁷ But beware of men, for they will hand you over to *the* courts and scourge you in their synagogues; ¹⁸ and you will even be brought before governors and kings for My sake, as a testimony to them and to the Gentiles.

I am the good shepherd Matthew 10:11

²¹ "Brother will betray brother to death, and a father *his* child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death.²² You will be hated by all because of My name, but it is the one who has endured to the end who will be saved. ²³ "But whenever they persecute you in one city, flee to ^[u]the next; for truly I say to you, you will not finish *going through* the cities of Israel until the Son of Man comes.





²⁴ "A disciple is not above his teacher, nor a slave above his master.²⁵ It is enough for the disciple that he become like his teacher, and the slave like his master. If they have called the head of the house ^[w]Beelzebul, how much more *will they malign* the members of his household!

²⁸ "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? ²⁹ For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, ³⁰ saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'
